Looking ahead to turnout

Getting your vaccines in before turnout will protect your stock as they approach a time of high disease risk

Lungworm

This year lungworm is particularly prevalent due to the mild, wet conditions **Huskvac** vaccination is recommended for cattle approaching their first grazing season or naive animals e.g. purchased from the East of the country

Two doses should be given 4 weeks apart, with the 2nd dose administered at least 2 weeks before turnout

Immunity is maintained from season to season by the exposure to lungworm larvae when grazing pasture
